SAN Receiving and Distribution Center Highlights



IMPROVED OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY The 23,000 square foot facility provides the San Diego International Airport with a centralized delivery location for food, beverage, retail and other goods eliminating the duplicity, pollution, traffic, and costs associated with multiple logistics supply chain networks and number of smaller facilities scattered throughout the airport complex.

ENHANCED AIRPORT SAFETY AND SECURITY By establishing a single operations center with a **highly controlled and monitored supply chain**, the new Receiving and Distribution Center **dramatically reduces the threat of a compromised distribution operation**.

A WORLD FIRST IN SUSTAINABILITY The United States Green Building Council has awarded the San Diego RDC with a LEED Gold Certification, making it the first facility at San Diego to receive such an honored designation and **the only receiving and distribution center in the world to have earned that certification**.

REDUCED ROADWAY AND PASSENGER SECURITY SCREENING CHECKPOINT CONGESTION The centralized location and operation of the RDC has reduced delivery truck traffic on the passenger roadways by 50-75 trips a day and virtually eliminated screening requirements at the security screening checkpoints in the passenger terminals.

IMMEDIATE COST SAVINGS With the comprehensive installation of leading sustainability practices, water efficient plumbing utilizes 40% less potable water and drought tolerant landscaping reduces the facility's overall water consumption by 54%.

EXEMPLARY PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP By partnering with AFCO, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority was able to acquire **essential facilities without using its bonding capacity** and **complete the project under an accelerated timetable** that would not have been possible under a traditional airport project procurement model.
